_____ **Complete Application and Hold Harmless Agreement.**

_____ **Narrative:** Type clearly what you want to be read by the parade announcer. Please keep to 75 words or less and spell names phonetically.

_____ **Group Insurance:** ALL ENTRIES must provide evidence of insurance for bodily injury and property damage with a combined single limit of \$200,000 or split limits of \$150,000 each person and \$400,000 each occurrence bodily injury liability and \$100,000 property damage liability. **The certificate of insurance must be provided with Yakima Sunfair Festival Association and City of Yakima as the named additional insured.**

_____ **Vehicle Insurance:** A copy of the Declarations Page from your insurance policy showing your Limits of Liability with a note for quick reference of the PARADE ENTRY and/or PARTICIPANT BY NAME.

Parade Information

All entries are by invitation only and must be preregistered. If you show up the day of the parade, you may not be announced, and you may have to pay a \$50.00 late entry fee. Parade application does not guarantee participation.

Entrants must observe all applicable rules and regulations and follow all instructions from police and parade officials. The Yakima Sunfair Festival Association and the Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entrant from the parade either prior to assembly, at assembly, or at any time during the parade. No one may participate in any manner deemed unsafe or not conforming to the standards of reasonable community taste and decency. Entries that do not fully comply with jeopardize future invitations to the parade.

Any entrant opposing, advocating, or depicting any social or religious issues are subject to approval of the Yakima Sunfair Festival Association.

If the American Flag is visible on your entry, it MUST be displayed properly. It must be larger and placed higher than any other country or association flag. No other flag should be placed to the right of the American Flag.

Entries, excluding bands, wishing to be judged must be in the staging area by 8 am.

Parade participants may not mingle with parade spectators. Participants may not jump off and on the back of a moving vehicle. No one can ride on the running boards, hood, roof, or vehicle fenders.

No water, or other material spraying device (confetti guns, etc.) are allowed during the parade except with permission by the parade committee.

Alcoholic beverages or any illegal substance are strictly forbidden and will be cause for immediate dismissal from the parade. No profanity is allowed.

No material (candy, literature, products, etc.) may be thrown along the parade route! Walkers may hand out pre-approved items directly to parade spectators.

Only forward movement maneuvers are permitted along the parade route. Maintain a spacing of two vehicles (about 30 feet) between each entry. All units are required to open or close the gap between units when asked to do so by parade officials.

Entries with children under age 13 must provide parents or other adults to supervise.

Walkers with bands, floats, etc. should wear appropriate clothing to identify them with their respective band or float.

Cell phones are prohibitive unless for emergency use.

FLOAT ENTRIES: Floats are not to exceed 13.5 feet in height (due to streetlights), 16 feet wide or 60 feet long.

If in view, drivers must be appropriately attired. Drivers must remain within their float throughout staging and the parade.

All participants riding on floats must have a slide in body support or an approved automotive safety belt or have handholds while the float is moving. Safety belts must be worn on the outside of garments.

BANDS: Bands will be judged during the parade route. All marching units must be in full uniform. Chaperones must be in school colors or dressed appropriately. There will be an inspection of all units in the Staging Area as

part of the judging procedure. Band Directors will receive more specific information on time to arrive, staging placement, etc. with your application approval.

EQUESTRIAN ENTRIES: NO STALLIONS. Each rider or group must provide his or her own clean up. Any unit without a cleanup unit will not be allowed on the parade route. Only one rider per horse is allowed. Any rider deemed unable to control his/her animal will be dismissed from the parade.

SPECIALTY UNITS: Entries are not to exceed dimensions as noted under FLOAT ENTRIES above. Any entry that does not match the description of photograph or their unit will be denied entry. Each entry featuring a classic or unique vehicle is limited to 20 vehicles unless otherwise approved by the parade committee. Each vehicle should be listed on the parade application.

ANNOUNCER NARRATIVE INFORMATION

The narrative is what will be read about your entry as you travel the parade route. Please write it word for word as you wanted it read. No more than 75 words. Please type your narrative in size 16 font so the announcer can easily read it and spell names phonetically.
